

A1 Impact of Government Participation on Satisfaction with Democracy

Table A1 reports the results of a linear regression with fixed effects for ESS rounds and clustered standard errors with ESS rounds as cluster variable. The dependent variable is satisfaction with democracy. It is demonstrated that government participation significantly affects satisfaction with democracy in model 1. Moreover, the interaction in model 2 demonstrates that this is particularly the case for the populist FPÖ voters, who are more satisfied with democracy when their preferred party is part of the governmental coalition. This can also be seen in Figure A1, which presents AME for government participation on satisfaction with democracy among the party supporters (based on model 2 in Table A1). The change in satisfaction with democracy among FPÖ supporters is over 1.5 points when their preferred party is in government.
