Çegerek, Yasemin	Labour	23-1-2014	I was sworn in as a Member of Parliament and shortly afterwards I became a mother for the first time [...]
Günel-Gezer, Sultan	Labour	12-12-2012	Proud that as the daughter of a guest worker [...] I can now hold the highest political office as a representative of the people.
Kat, Hülya	Democrats 66	30-11-2021	They made no distinction between my brothers and myself : developing their own thoughts and freedom of choice.
Mutluer, Songül	Labour	20-04-2022	As the middle child of six daughters [...]
Piri, Kati	Labour	19-5-2021	As a little girl I didn't understand that.
Sahla, Fonda	Democrats 66	14-4-2022	Even though this inequality of opportunity was visible everywhere in my environment, at school and in the neighbourhood, it was not addressed at that time. That realization only came to me afterwards, when I became a mother myself.
Simons, Sylvana	BIJ1	29-4-2021	In front of you stands a proud woman , a woman who has already conquered a lot in life.
Tanamal, Grace	Labour	27-6-2013	It is an honour for me to be the first woman of Moluccan descent to stand in the House of Representatives.
Wuite, Jorien	Democrats 66	13-10-2021	I also stand here for the younger Dutch generation, and a lot of women , who openly and honestly indicate to me that they have learned too little about the colonial past and who think that this must be rectified.
