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Introduction


Nearly 1 in 4 Americans report financial barriers to accessing healthcare, leading to poorer outcomes and quality of life. This poster presents key results from a market survey by ChiKobi Health examining interrelationships between financial hardship, unmet healthcare needs, and emotional, psychical and social health. As climate change escalates systemic crisis, expanding access to preventative and personalized medicine is an urgent public health priority.

Background

Financial obstacles to getting care or treatment are associated with emotional distress, uncontrolled chronic conditions, delayed diagnoses, and general declines across wellbeing dimensions like daily functioning and social health.


Key Results

- Emotional Distress: A staggering 88% of participants reported experiencing emotional distress frequently, primarily attributed to healthcare and financial concerns
- **Quality of Life vs. Chronic Pain**: Despite 80% rating their quality of life positively, a notable 40% reported chronic pain significantly interfering with their daily activities.
- Healthcare Management Interest: Around 60%



Methods

- 47-respondent online survey with 20 questions of healthcare, finances and wellbeing
- Recruitment via social media and community engagement
- Data analysis in Excel using correlations, histograms and descriptive statistics




- of respondents showed a keen interest in personalized healthcare management services.
- Holistic Product Interest: A significant 84% were inclined towards integrative wellness products, indicating a shift towards holistic health solutions.



Conclusion

The survey reveals a significant link between financial strain, healthcare challenges, and overall well-being. 



