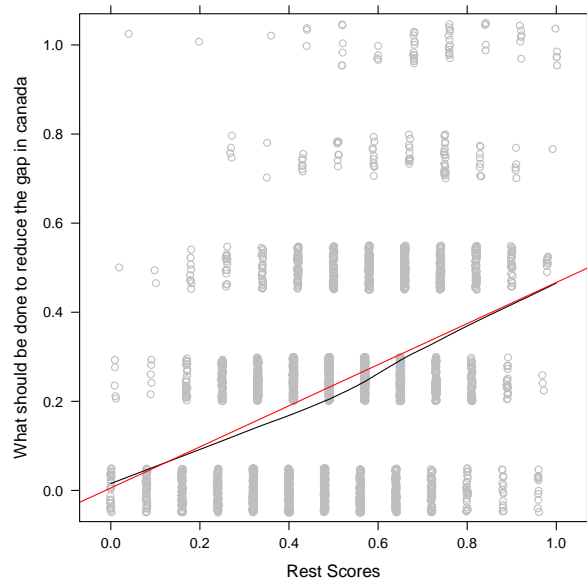

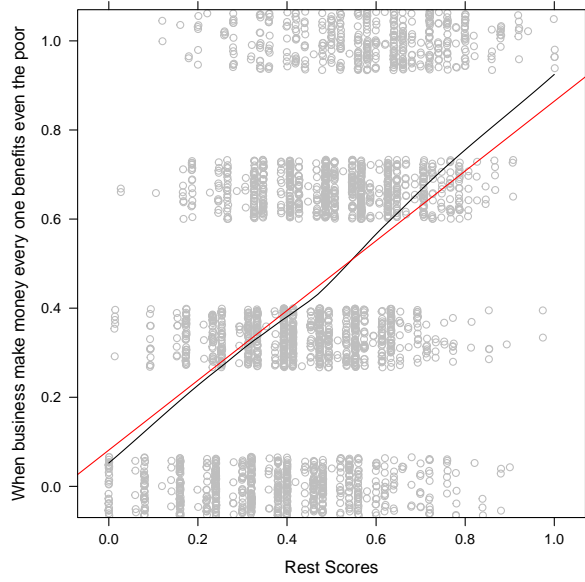

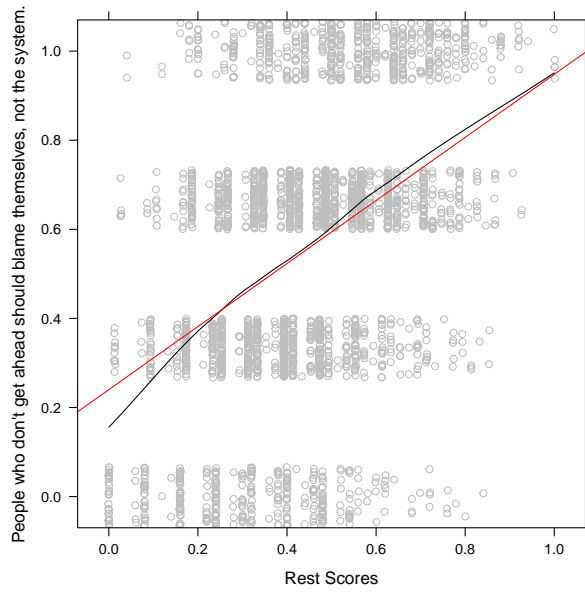

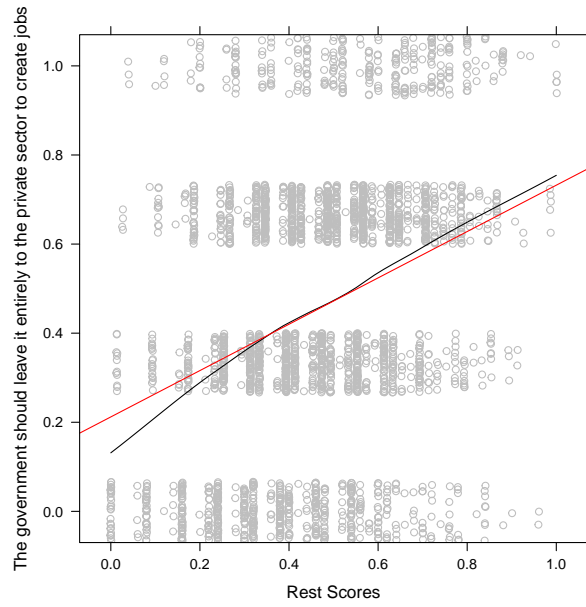
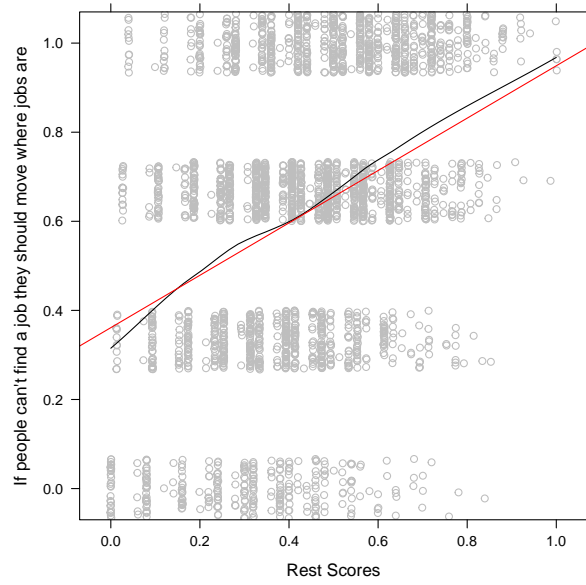

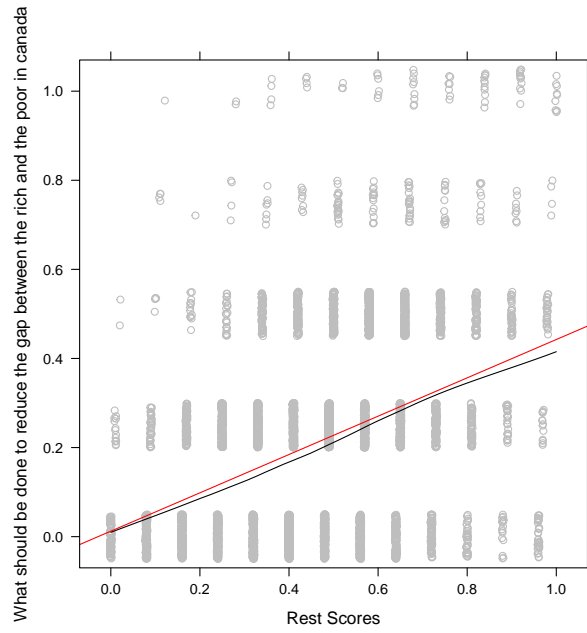

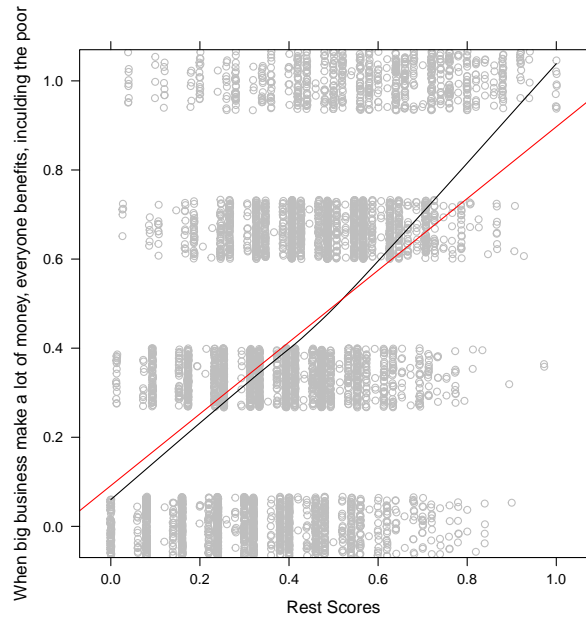

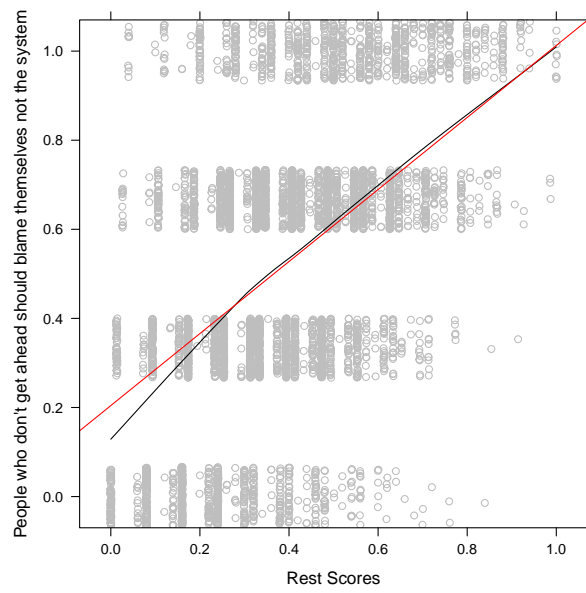

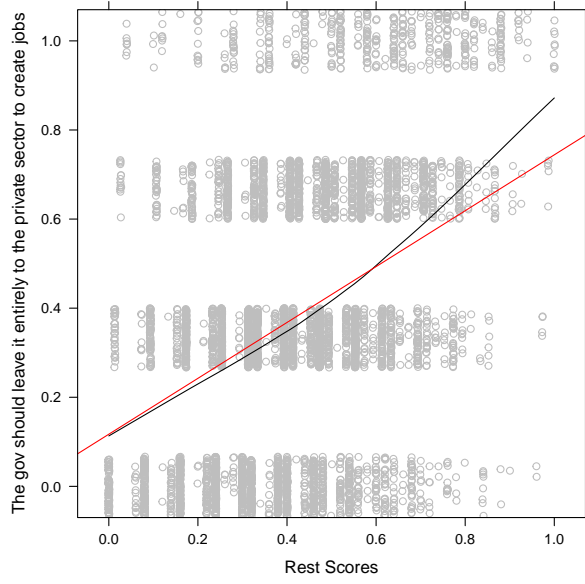
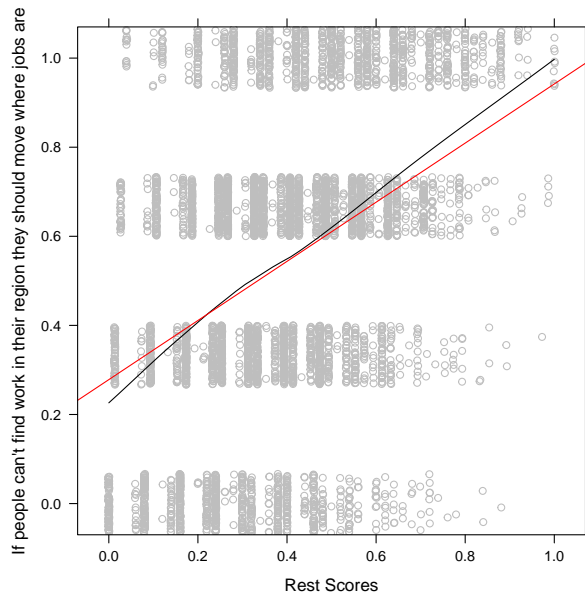

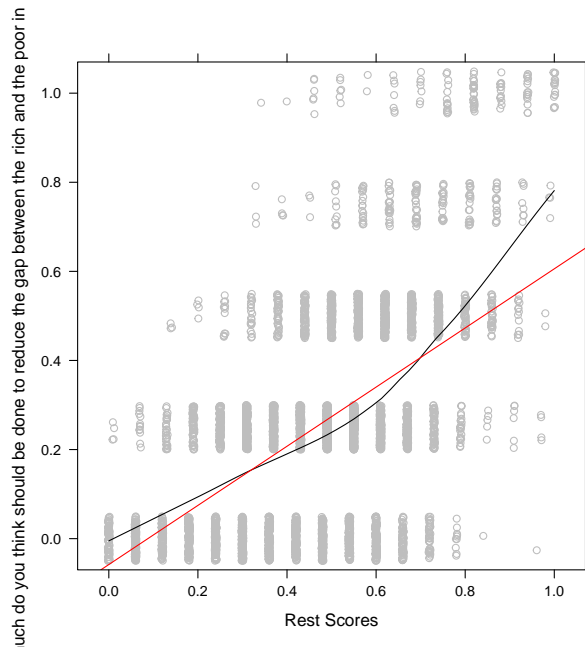

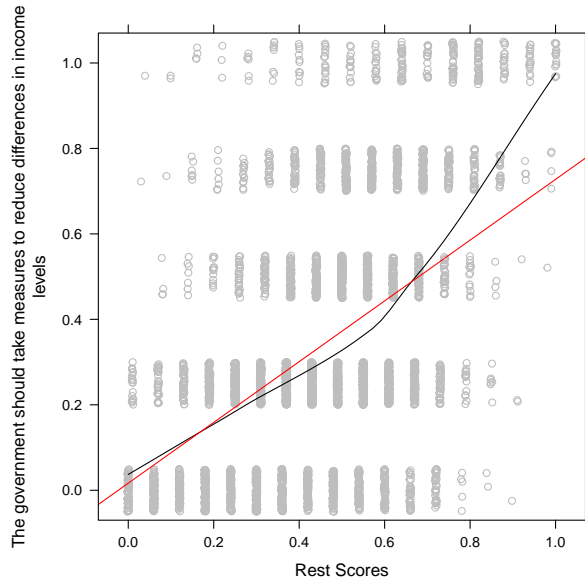

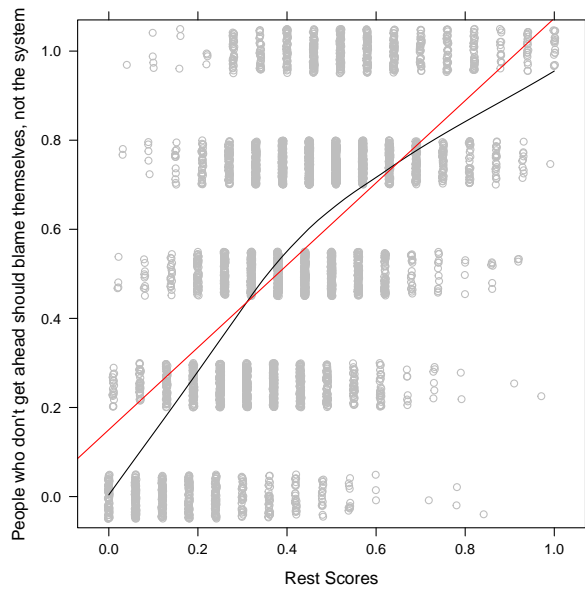

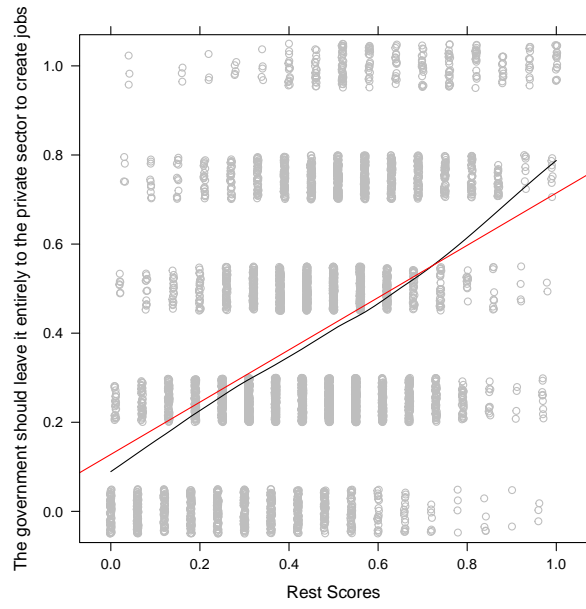

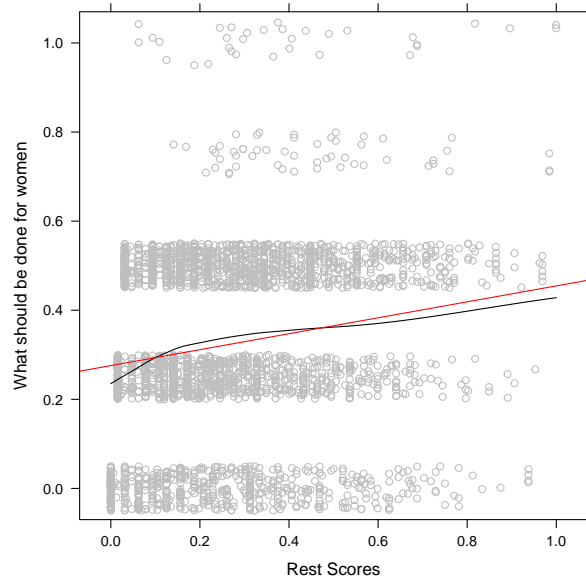

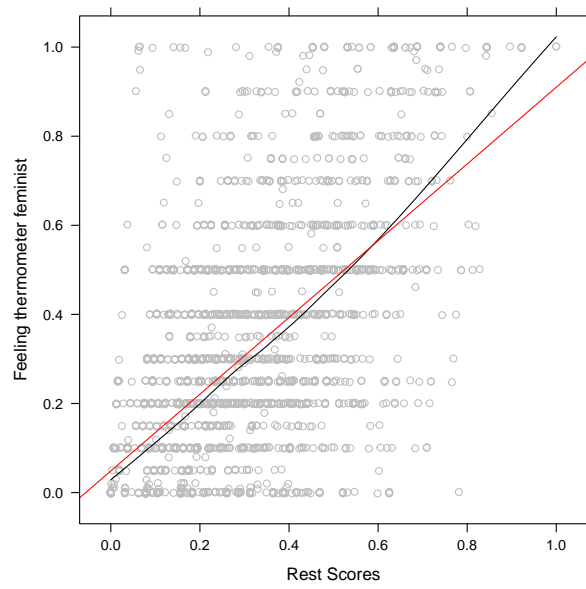
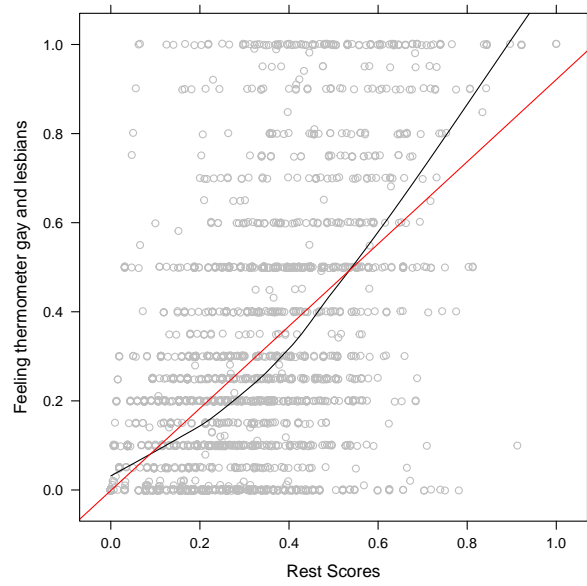

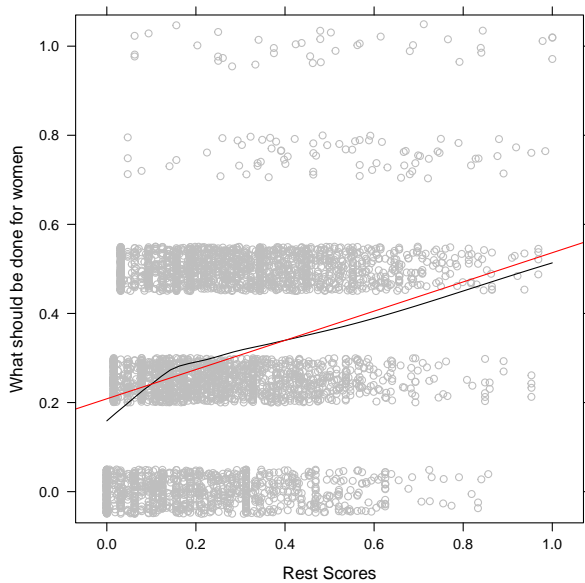

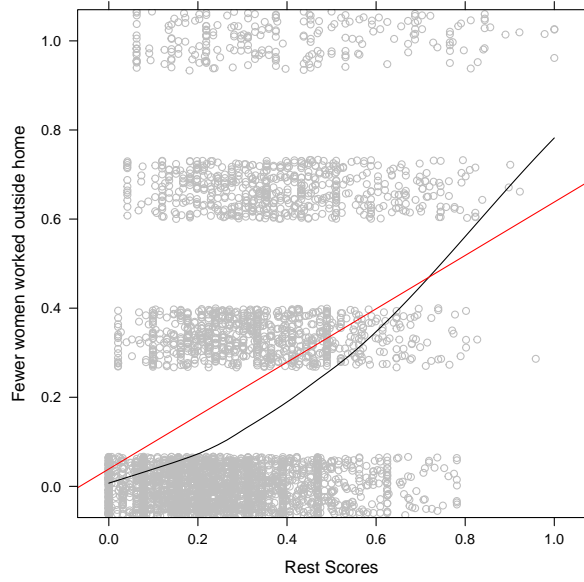

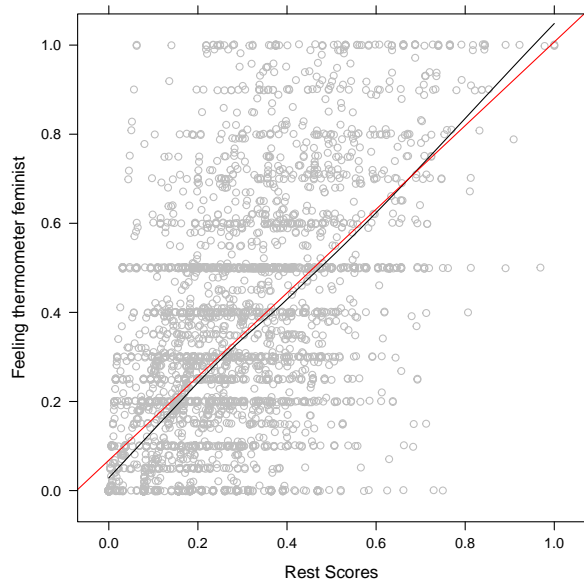

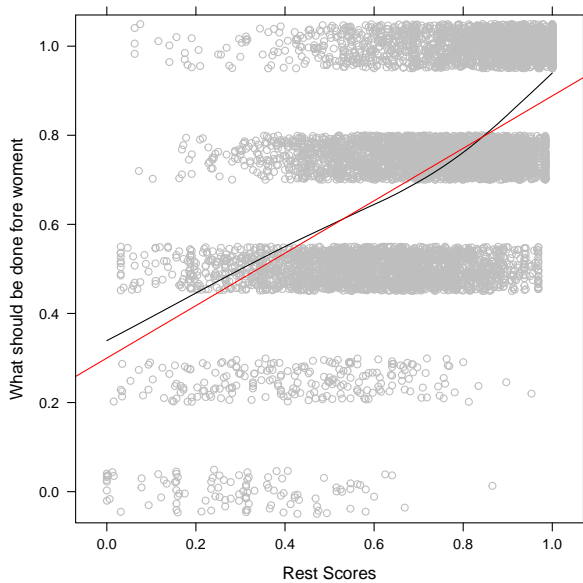

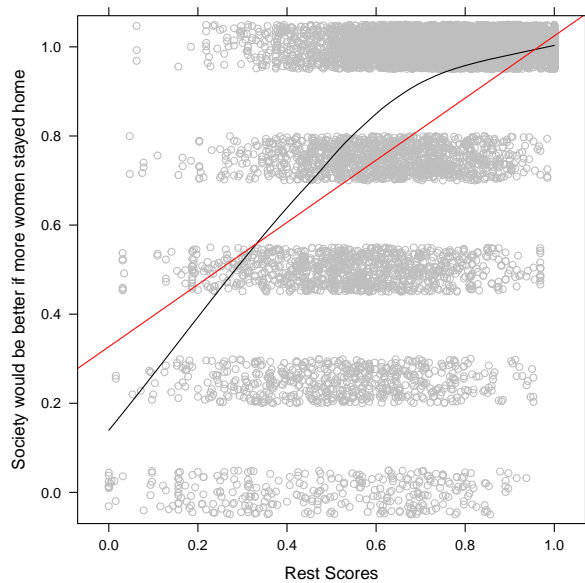

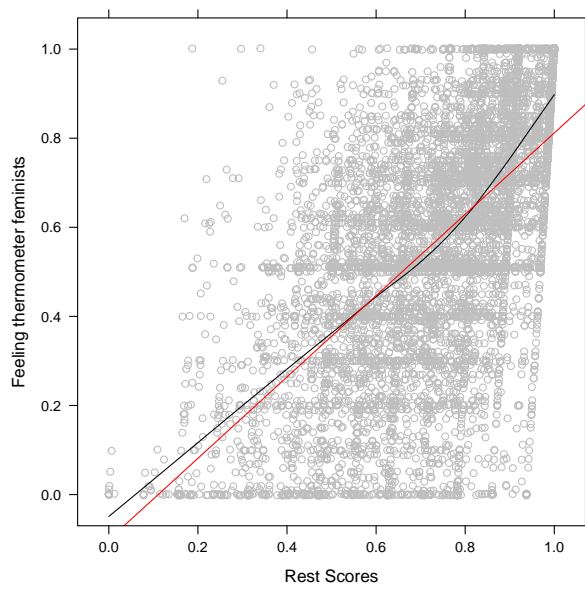
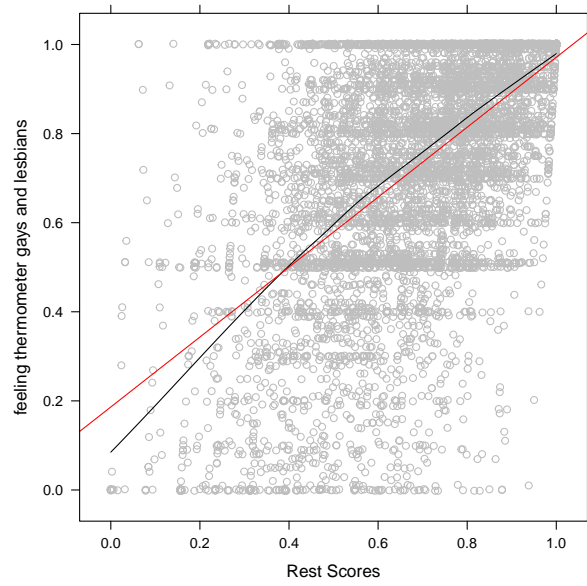

Figure. 28: Predicted partisanship with Multinomial regressions (2011)

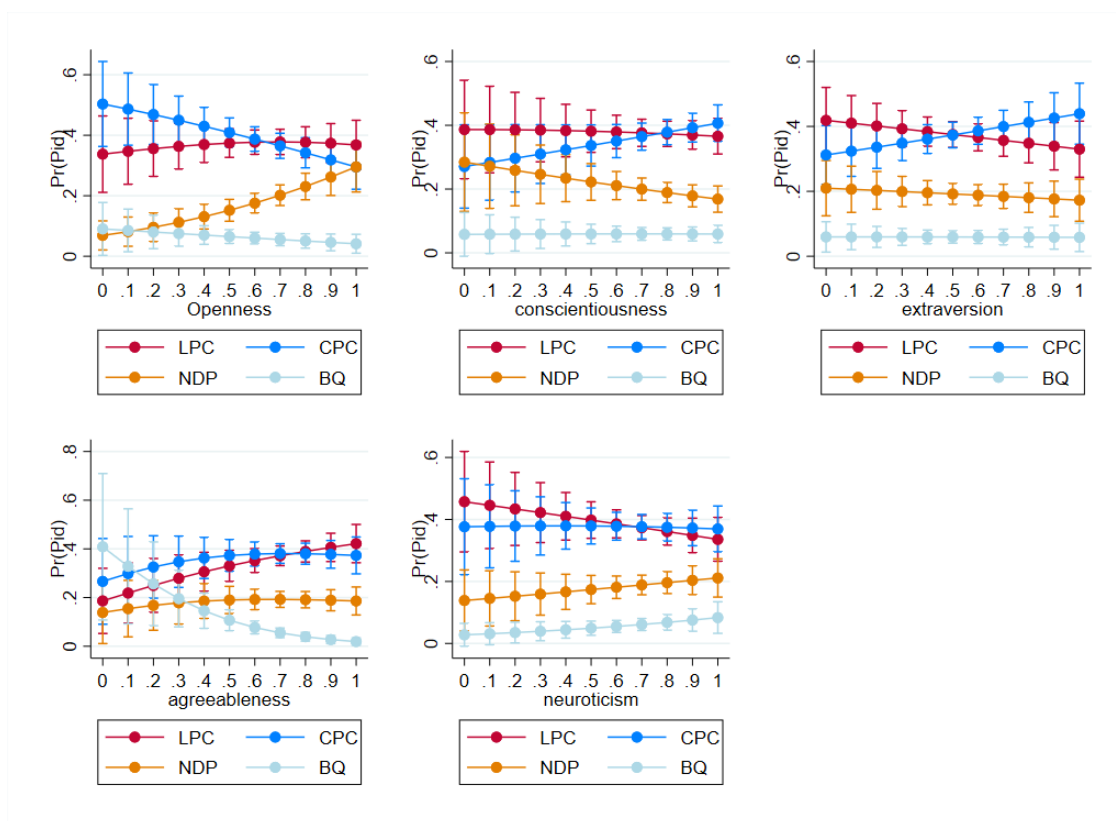


Figure. 29: Predicted partisanship with Multinomial regressions (2015)

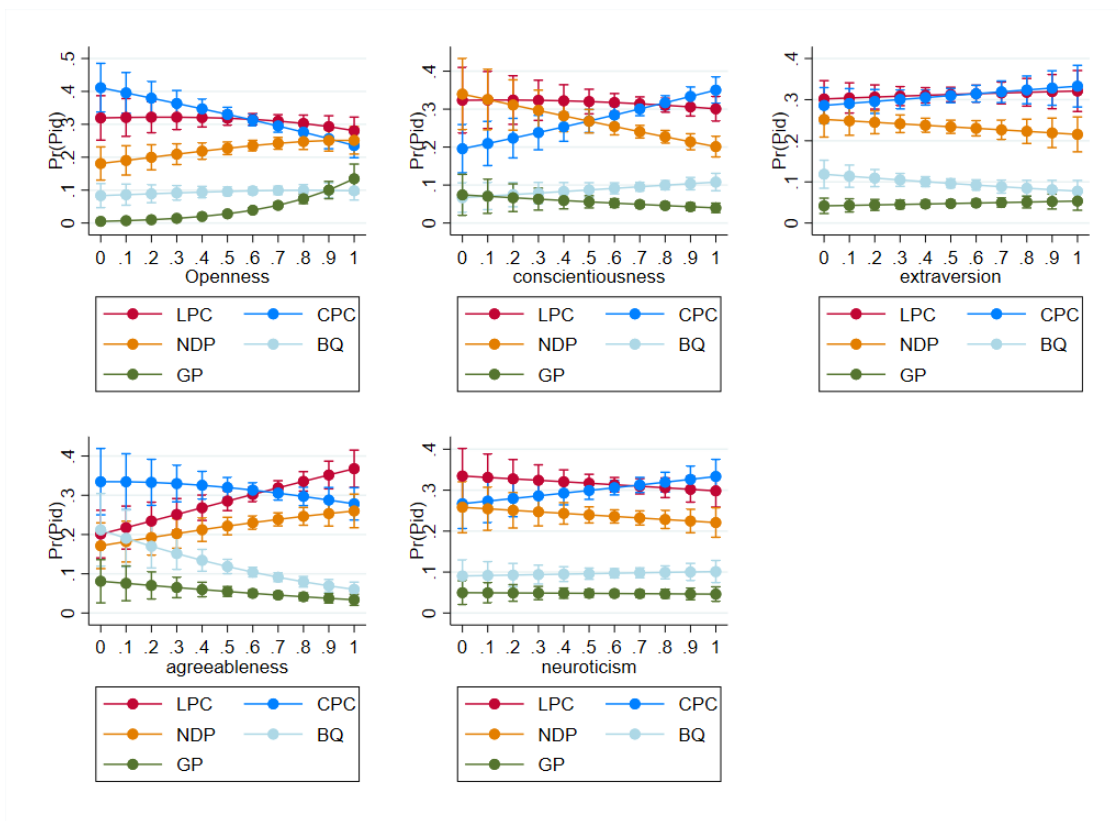


Figure. 30: Predicted partisanship with Multinomial regressions (2019)
