


Fig. 2. Photograph (a) and outline drawing (b) of *Noripterus* (GIN125/1010). Abbreviations: cap., carpus; cv., cervical vertebrae; d., dentary; dr., dorsal ribs; f., femur; h., humerus; j., jugal; mc., manual claw; mx., maxilla; nof., nasoantorbital opening; or., orbit; pc., parietal crest; pt., pteroid; pm., premaxilla; rd., radius; sc., scapula; ti., tibia; ul., ulna; wm., wing metacarpal; wph1-wph2, wing phalange 1 and wing phalange 2.




Fig.3. The skull of *Noripterus* (GIN125/1010) (a), a close up of its dentition (b) and partial skull of *Noripterus* (GIN125/1010-1a). Abbreviations: j., jugal; nof., nasoantorbital opening; pm.+m., premaxilla and maxilla; q., quadrate; qj., quadratojugal; sc, sagittal crest; ts., tooth sockets; Scale bars = 50 mm.




Fig.5. Postcranial skeleton of different individual of *Noripterus* (GIN125/1010-1b) (a), Close up of teeth scattered among bones (b).
