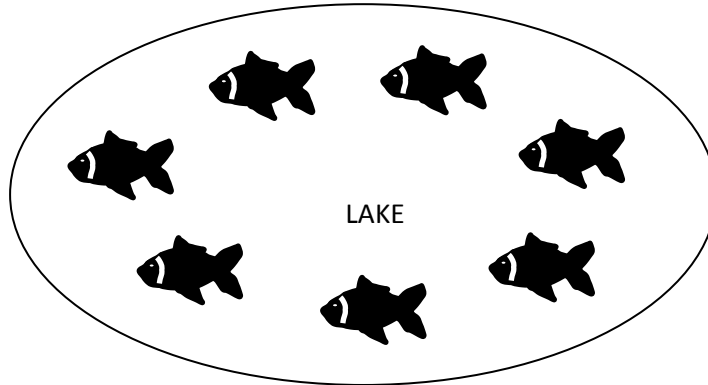

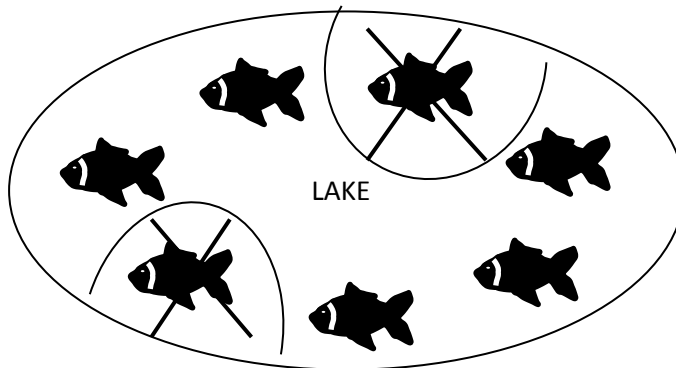

SUPPLEMENTARY MATERIAL 1 Management options for Lake Alaotra fisheries.

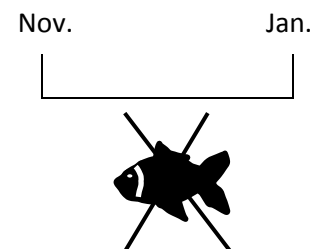
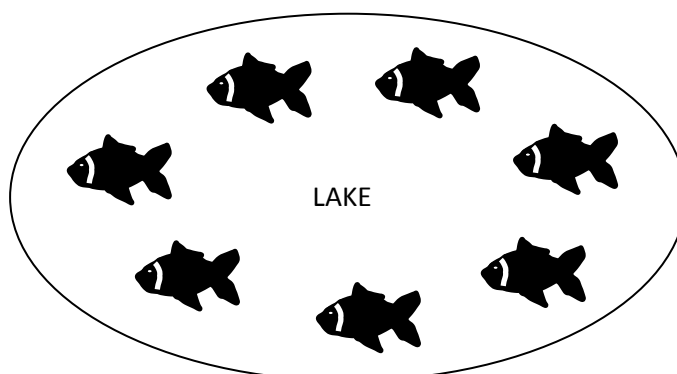
Option A: without closed fishing seasons or permanent closed fishing zones



Option B: without closed fishing seasons but with the establishment of permanent reserves where fishing is prohibited throughout the year

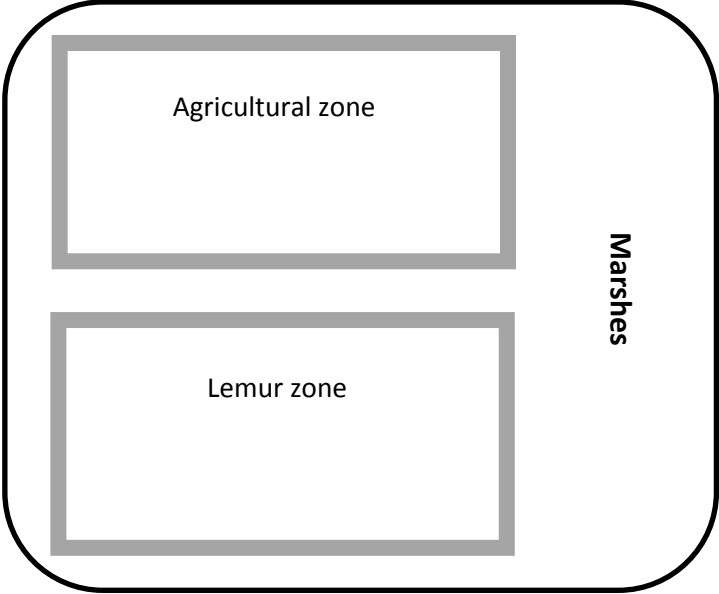


Option C: closed fishing season from November until January, a policy that is currently in place



SUPPLEMENTARY MATERIAL 2 Management options for the marshes.

Option A: distinct zoning for *Hapalemur alaotrensis* and agriculture (participants from Andreba) [land sparing]



Option B: no zoning at all [land sharing]
