Codes of Ethics: prevalence and form of ethical resources of WPA member societies

The tables below includes information on all member societies of the World Psychiatric Association (WPA), following website reviews, to determine which societies have a code of ethics or other ethical resources. It is noted that some societies would fit into more than one category (e.g. it may have guidelines on specific ethical issues and and ethics committee, but have no code of ethics). Societies have been placed in the category most relevant. These table were developed followed web-based search methodologies for each society, using supplementary literature where relevant.
