9.2 SOUTHERN COUNTIES (EAST)

BERKSHIRE

- (1) Arborfield and Newland: denarius of Hadrian. Deposited c. A.D. 203-6 or later.¹
- (2) **Newell Green**, *Watersplash Lane*, *West Berkshire* (SU 8714 7118): evaluation trenching revealed a Roman ditch and several undated features.² Although only 26 sherds of pottery were recovered, all in variants of sandy grey wares, six appear to be from one vessel and twelve from another.
- (3) **Reading**, Ridgeway Primary School, South Reading (SU 7280 7030): hoard of 532 radiates in a ceramic vessel: Gordian III, 1; Philip I, 3; Joint reign of Valerian and Gallienus, 20 (Valerian, 2; Gallienus, 8; Salonina, 9; Valerian II, 1); Gallienus (sole reign), 88; Salonina (sole reign), 3; Claudius II, 69; Divus Claudius II, 2; Postumus, 77; Laelian, 1; Marius, 5; Victorinus, 135; Tetricus I, 86; Tetricus II, 12; Uncertain emperor, 26. Totals include irregular and possibly irregular coins, *c.* A.D. 274 or later. The hoard was contained within a damaged Alice Holt greyware flask and placed in a small pit which was partly within the subsoil above a ditch.³

EAST SUSSEX

(1) **Ringmer** *The Orchards, Uckfield Road* **(**TQ 4414 1383): excavation confirmed the presence of traces of the Roman road from Arlington to Barcombe, albeit severely truncated.⁴ It is possible that the road follows a natural geological ridge, which contains a large amount of iron pan and manganese inclusions.

KENT

1) **Alkham**: hoard of 1 solidus and 11 siliquae: Solidus: Honorius, Milan (*RIC* 1206, A.D. 395–402); *Siliquae*: A.D. 364–7, 2 (Rome); A.D. 375–8, 1 (Trier); A.D. 378–88, 4 (Trier); A.D. 379–95, 3 (Trier, 1; Trier or Aquileia, 1, Milan, 1); A.D. 393–402, 1 (Milan). Deposited *c.* A.D. 395–402 or later. The majority of the silver coins in the hoard are clipped.

- 2) **Ashford**, *Cheeseman's Green Area A1*, (TR 02398 39339): trial trenches recorded a set of undated parallel ditches adjacent to the known Roman Road to the south of Bilham Farm.⁶
- 3) **Ashford**, *Jarvis Land at Chilmington Green*, (TQ 97811 40109): evaluation identified prehistoric and medieval archaeology alongside shallow Romano-British ditches indicating agricultural activity at some distance from any settlement.⁷
- (4) **Sittingbourne**, *Regis Manor Primary School*, *Middletune Avenue* (TQ 90298 65174): a possible early Roman robbed-out wall was revealed, as a band of mortar that had adhered to the underlying strata.⁸

SURREY

(1) **Staines,** *land to the east of Hounslow Road* (TQ 0227 7158): two late Roman ditches were interpreted as field boundaries.⁹

WEST SUSSEX

- (1) **East of Billingshurst**: hoard of at least 22 radiates and fragments: Gallienus (sole reign), 3; Salonina (sole reign), 1; Claudius II, 8; Divus Claudius II, 1; Postumus, 1; Uncertain emperor, 7; Irregular, 1. Deposited *c.* A.D. 270 or later.¹⁰
- (2) **Compton**: 1 siliqua and 14 nummi. Siliqua A.D. 364–7 (Rome). Nummi: A.D. 335–7, 1 (Trier); A.D. 353–3, 1 (Arles); A.D. 364–75, 1 (Lyon or Arles); A.D. 364–78, 11 (Uncertain mint). Deposited *c.* A.D. 378 or later.¹¹
- (3) **Funtington**: 37 radiates: Gallienus (sole reign), 1; Salonina (sole reign), 4; Claudius II, 5; Victorinus, 2; Tetricus I, 8; Tetricus II, 4; Uncertain Gallic emperor, 6; Uncertain emperor, 7. Deposited *c.* A.D. 274 or later.¹²
