



# C Rationale for Discounting Regression Discontinuity in Time Approach

While we considered a Regression Discontinuity in Time (RDiT) design for this study, we had multiple concerns that it would not be an appropriate choice. These include concerns regarding the presence of unobservable covariates that may vary with time, the presence of time-varying treatment effects, autoregressive properties in the data, and the inability to test for sorting around the time threshold. The potential for unobservable time-varying covariates concerned us most greatly. We did not feel confident that we could discount that some other event may have occurred within our discontinuity bandwidth which might bias the pre-event period, the post-event period, or both. The four weeks surrounding Xi Jinping's announcement were filled with numerous notable media events including renewed interest in the COVID "lab-leak" theory, the NATO declaration of China as a security threat, a visit by US Senators to Taiwan, and the G7 meeting and statement on Xinjiang and Hong Kong, among others. Any of these events may have elicited WWD Twitter responses which may bias and limit the identifying power of a RDiT design.
