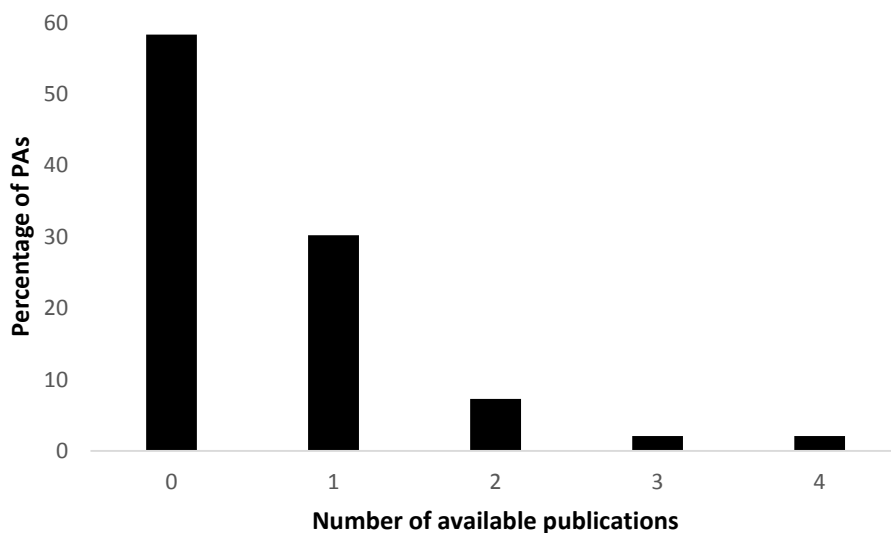


Figure S1. Relative frequency of PAs respect to number of available floristic publications.

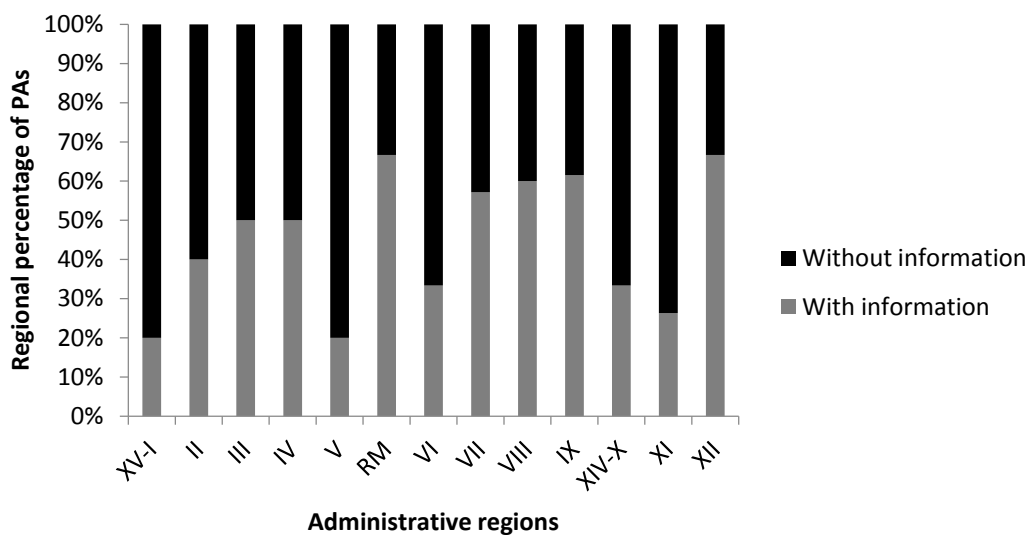


Figure S2. Percentage of PAs with and without information with respect to the regional total.

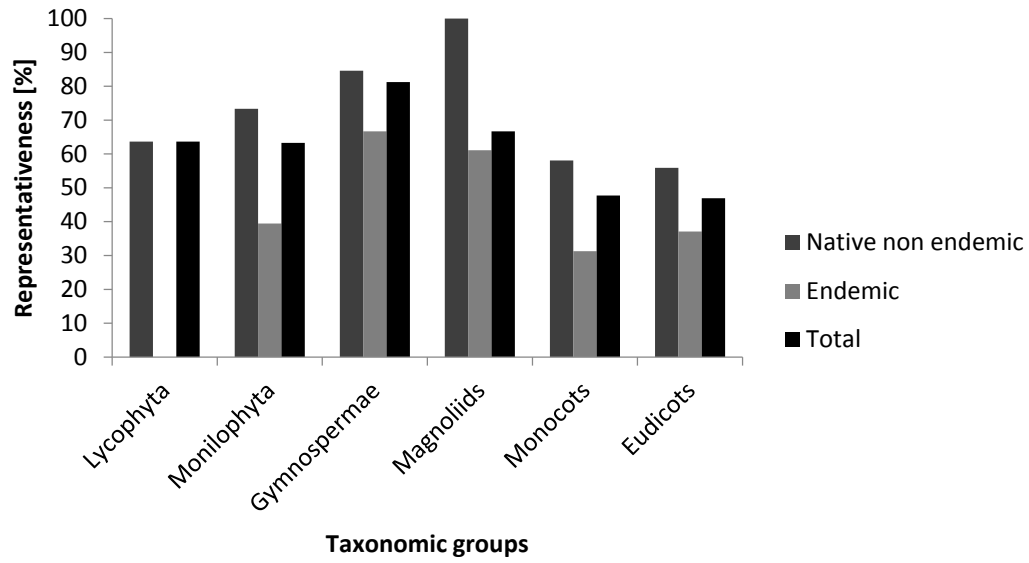


Figure S3. Representativeness of the main taxonomic groups in the SNASPE. \*Lycophyta is the only group with no endemic species in Chile.

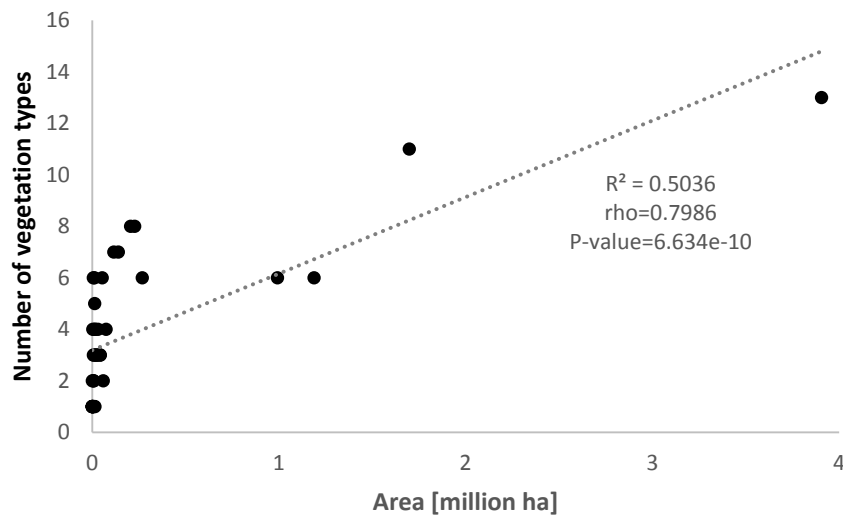


Figure S4. Relation between area and number of vegetation types represented in PAs.

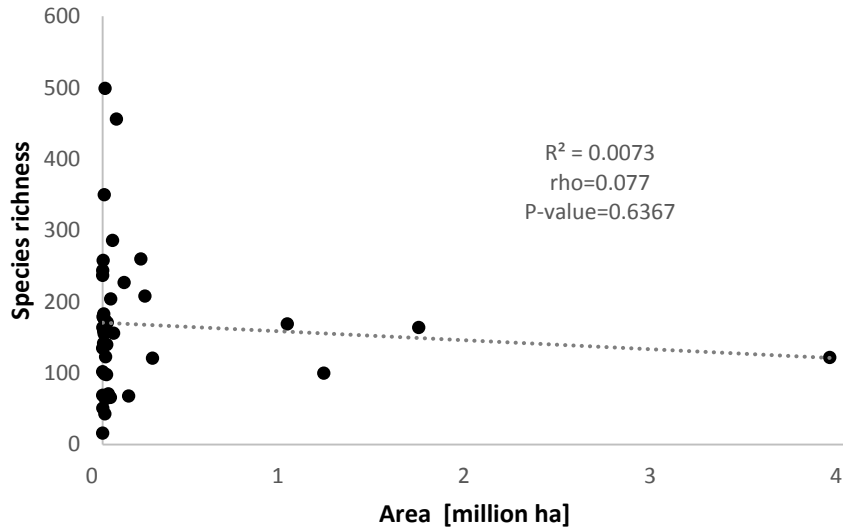


Figure S5. Relation between area and number of plant species represented in PAs.

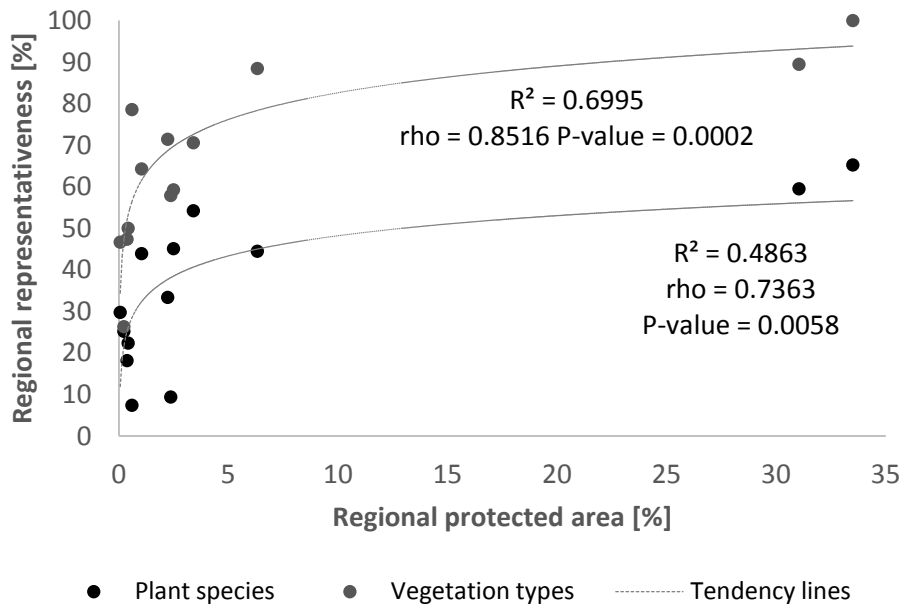


Figure S6. Relation between regional percentage of area protected and the representativeness of vegetation types and plant species.

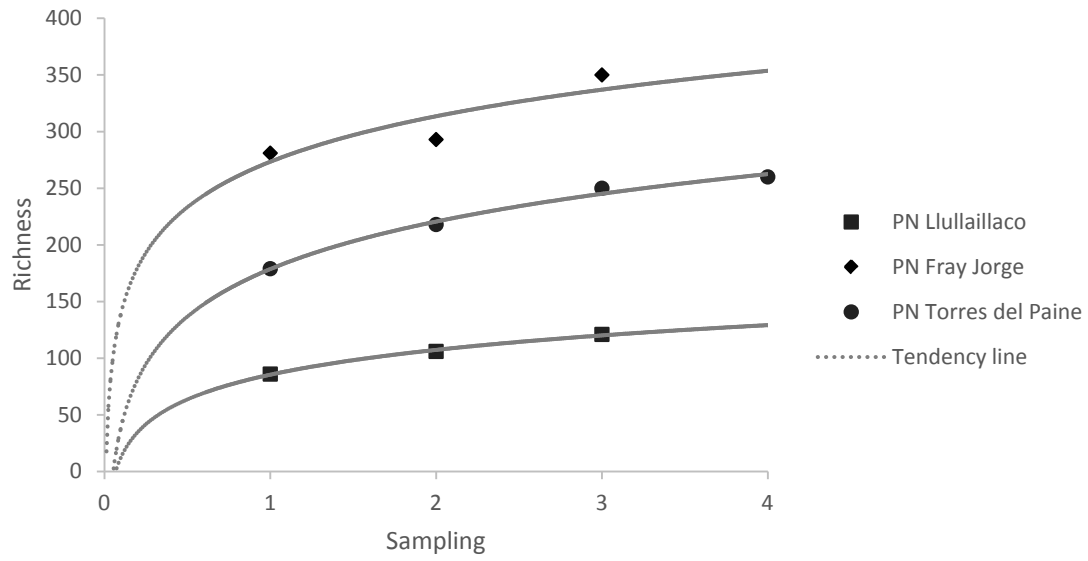
