

- NO antibiotics
- Provide patient education
- As symptoms dictate, may treat with^{2,5}:
- Antitussives: Eg. benzonatate (Tessalon Perles[®]), dextromethorphan (Delsym[®])
- Bronchodilators
 Eg. albuterol metered dose inhaler (ProAir[®])

- Chest x-ray may be considered if^{1,2}:
 - HR > 100 BPM
 - RR > 24 BPM
 - Temp >100.4° F (38° C)
 - Lung exam suggestive of focal consolidation
- *Purulent sputum does not predict bacterial infection and alone is not an indication for chest x-ray.
- Consider sputum culture and empiric antibiotic therapy as chest x-ray dictates^{2,3}
