

## Chemical, Biological, Radionuclear (CBRN) Personal Protection Equipment

Definition: Level of personal protection equipment (PPE)

PPE 1: Healthcare Uniform (ie scrubs) without specific protection

PPE 2: Contact and splash/droplet precautions, ie gloves, gown, surgical face mask, goggles

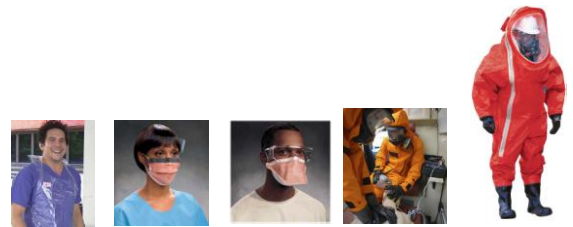
PPE 3: Contact, splash/droplet and airborne precautions, gloves, gown, goggles, HEPA/TB mask

PPE 4: Chemical resistant suit and air purifying respirator (gas mask)

PPE 5: Self contained breathing apparatus and fully encapsulating, pressurized suit (HAZMAT suit)
