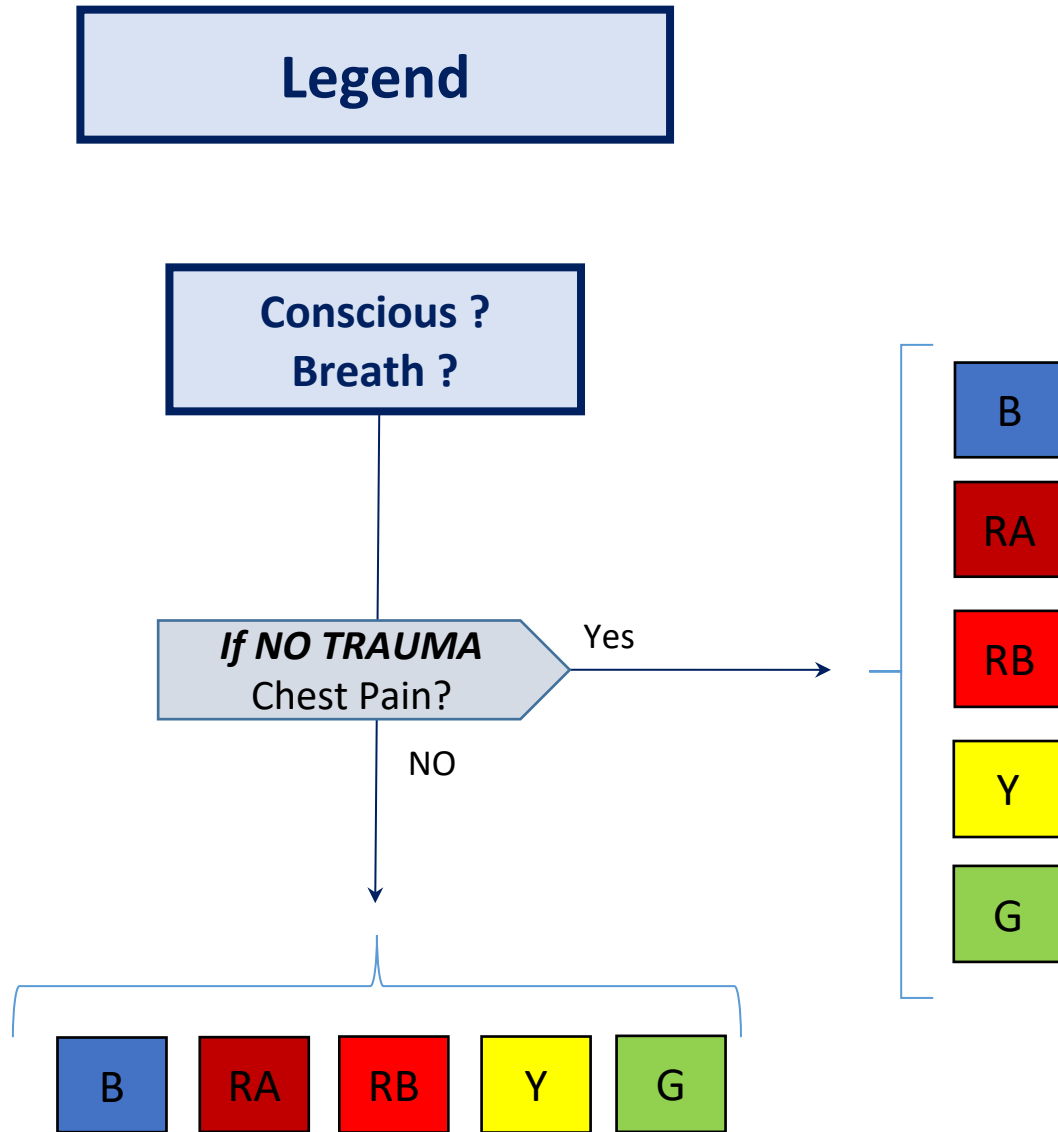
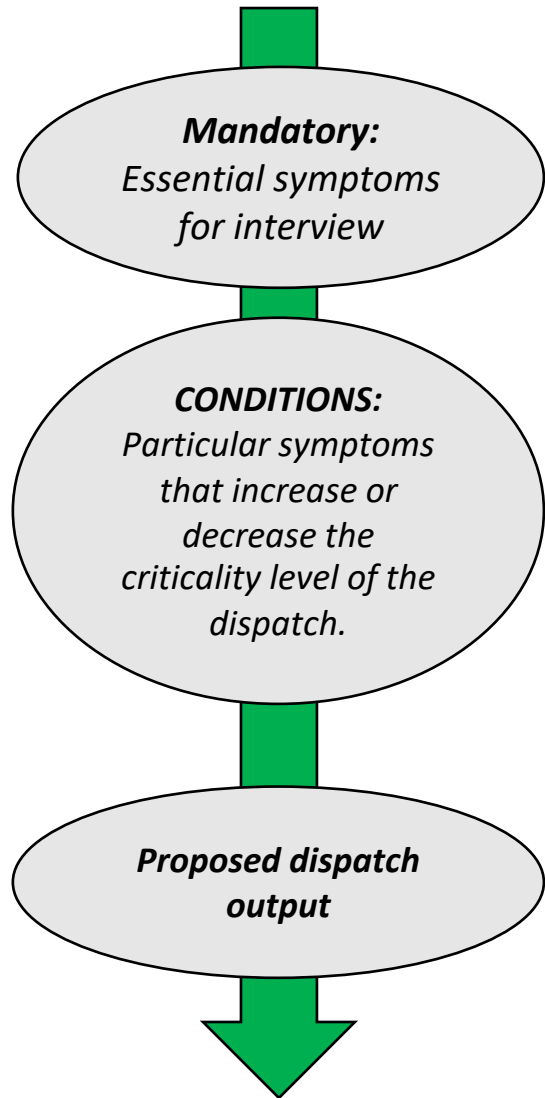

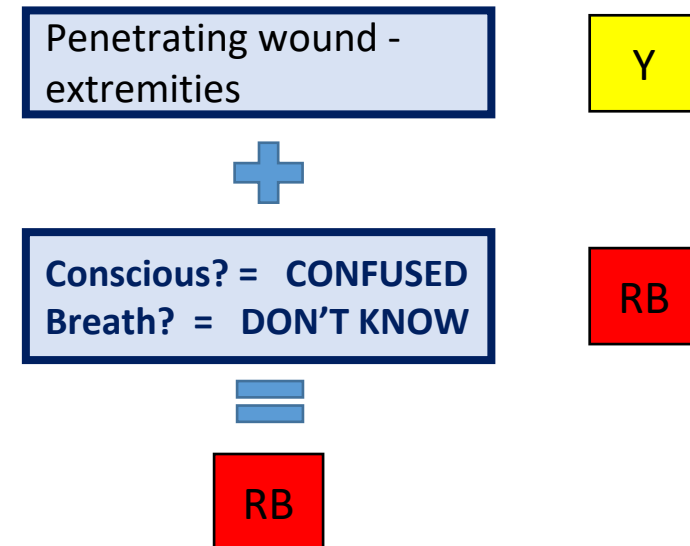

Algorithm 0 – ONE-SHOT

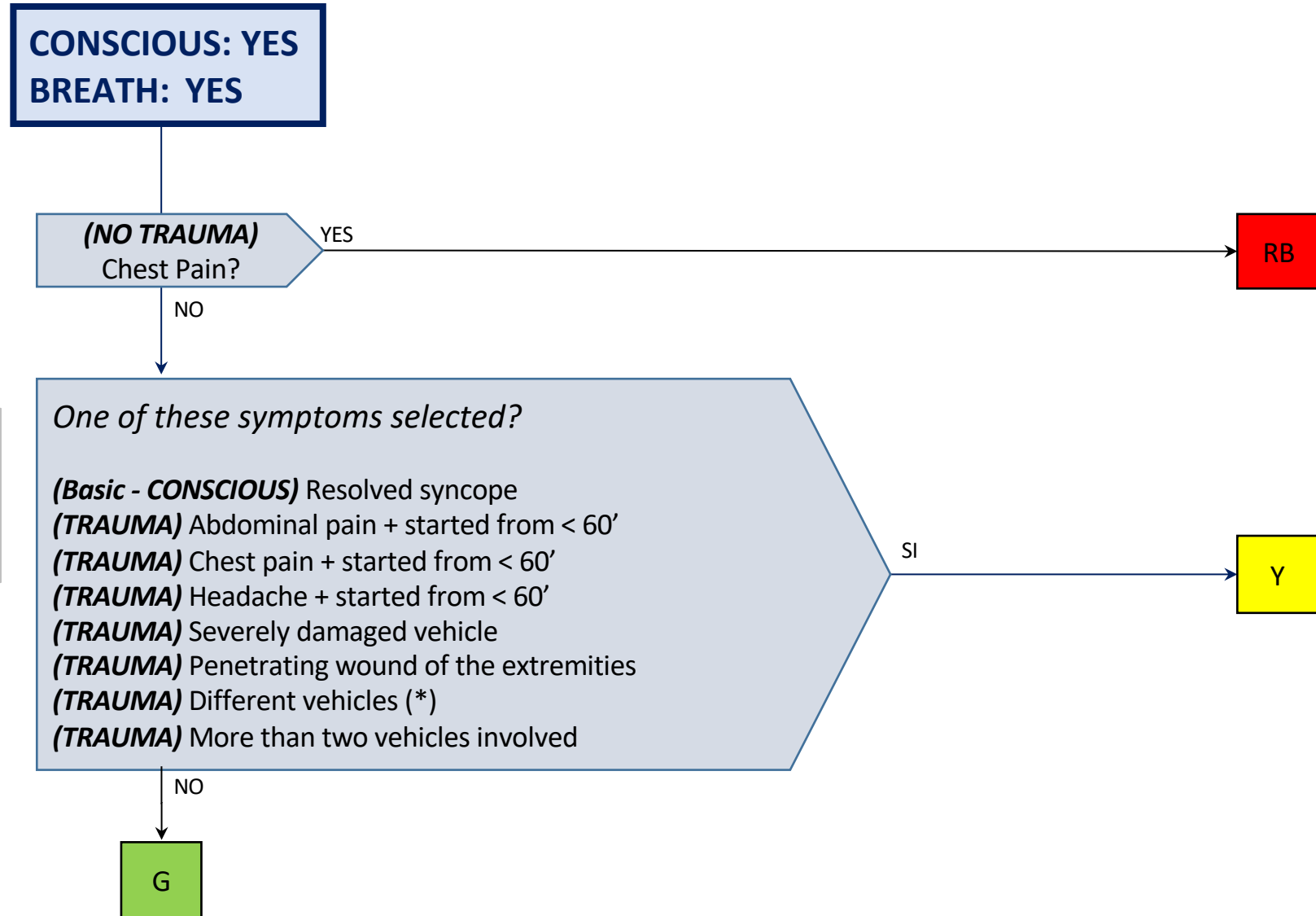
ONE-SHOT: Symptom or condition directly associated to a severity code (independently of the algorithm). The dispatch code could be overwritten only in case of other concomitant symptoms or conditions of increased criticality level (see the example on the right).

Symptom	Code
Severe dyspnoea	RED Advanced
Gunshot wound - head/trunk	RED Advanced
Penetrating wound - head/trunk	RED Advanced
Trapped in the vehicle	RED Advanced
Passenger ejected from vehicle	RED Advanced
Fall from over 3 meters	RED Advanced
Breath - No	RED Advanced
Breath – Don't know + Conscious	RED Basic
Breath – Don't know + Confused	RED Basic
Gunshot wound - extremities	RED Basic
Penetrating wound - extremities	Yellow
Stroke suspected	Yellow
Pregnancy	Yellow



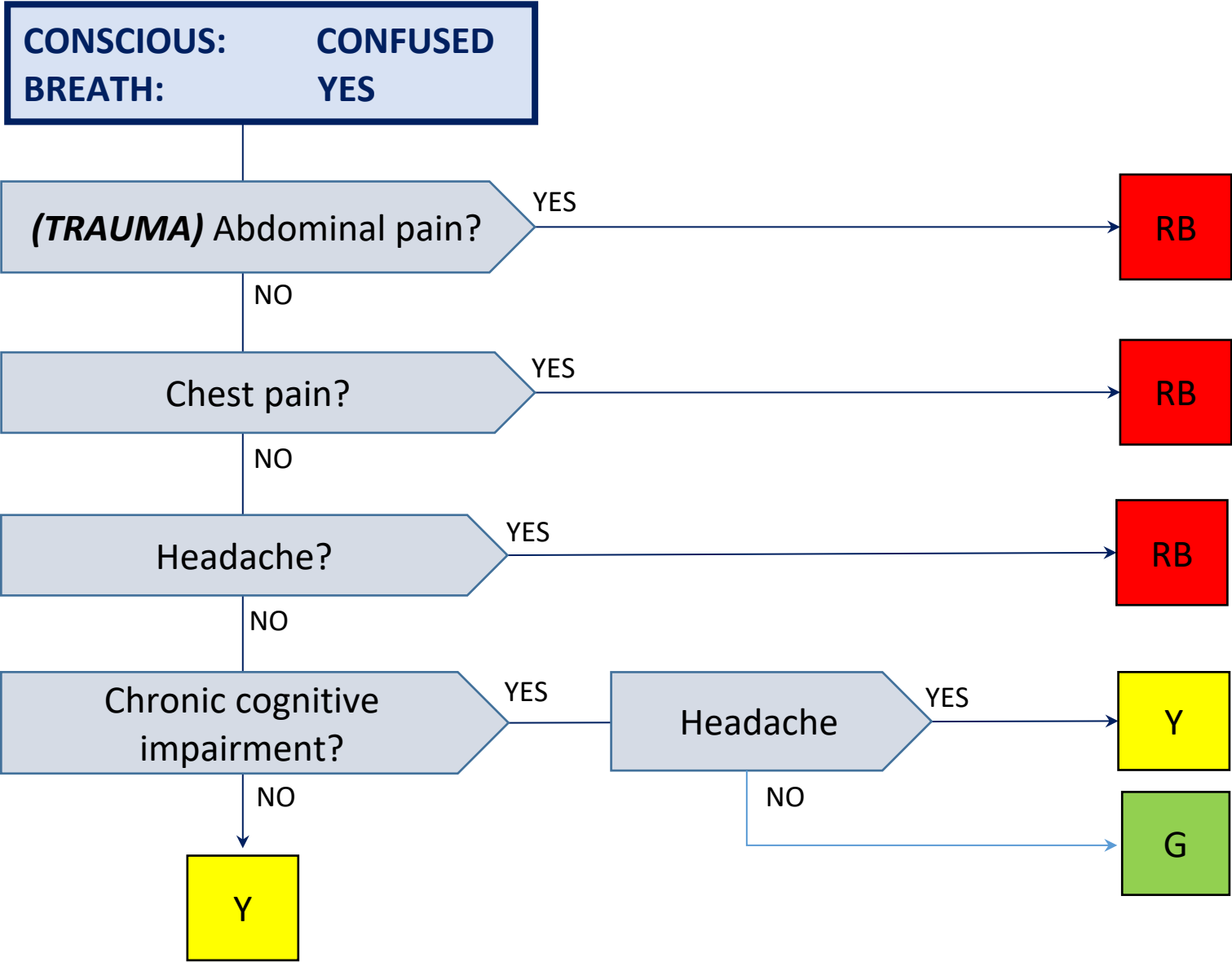
ONE-SHOT items could ONLY INCREASE the criticality level.

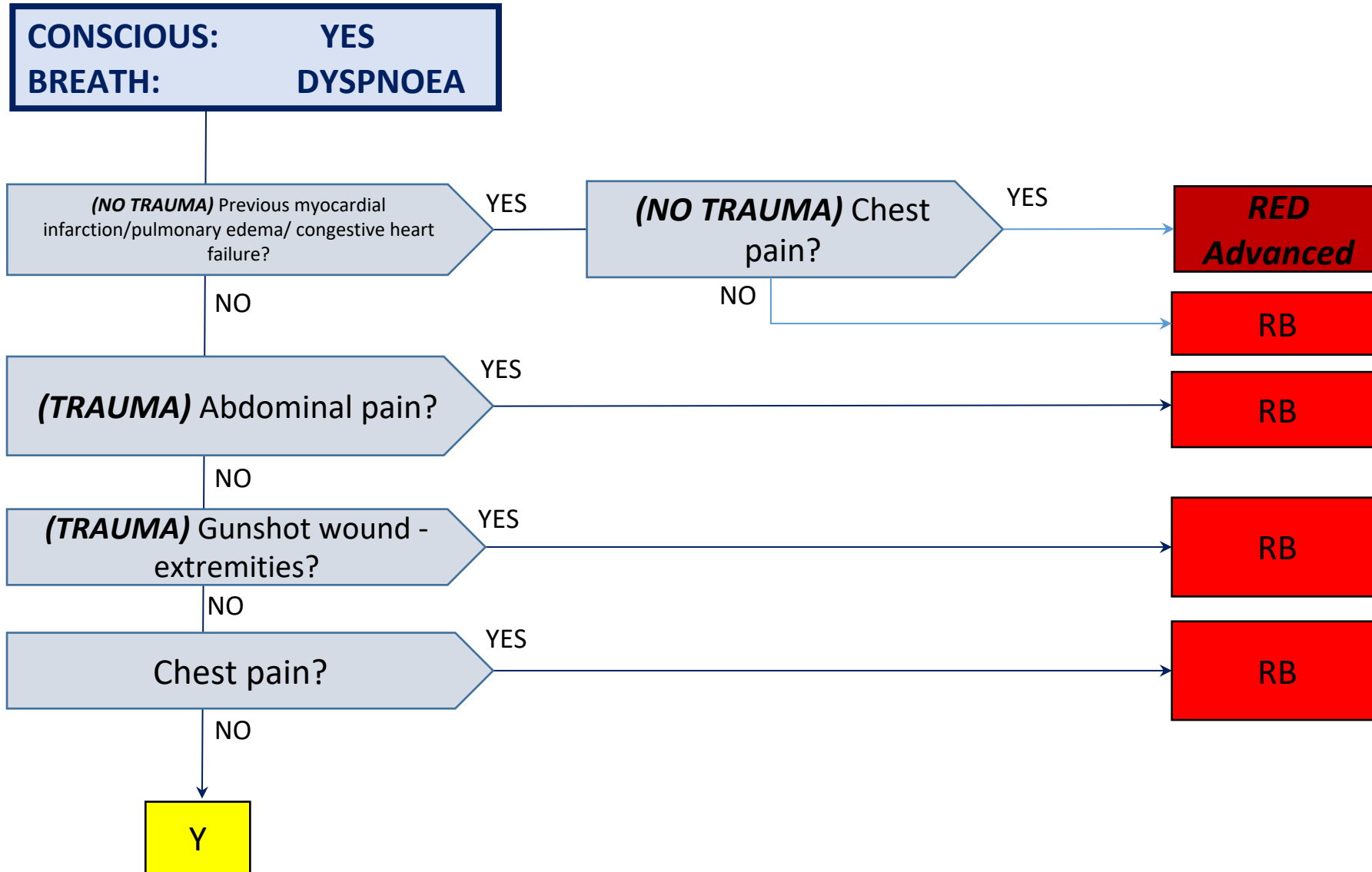

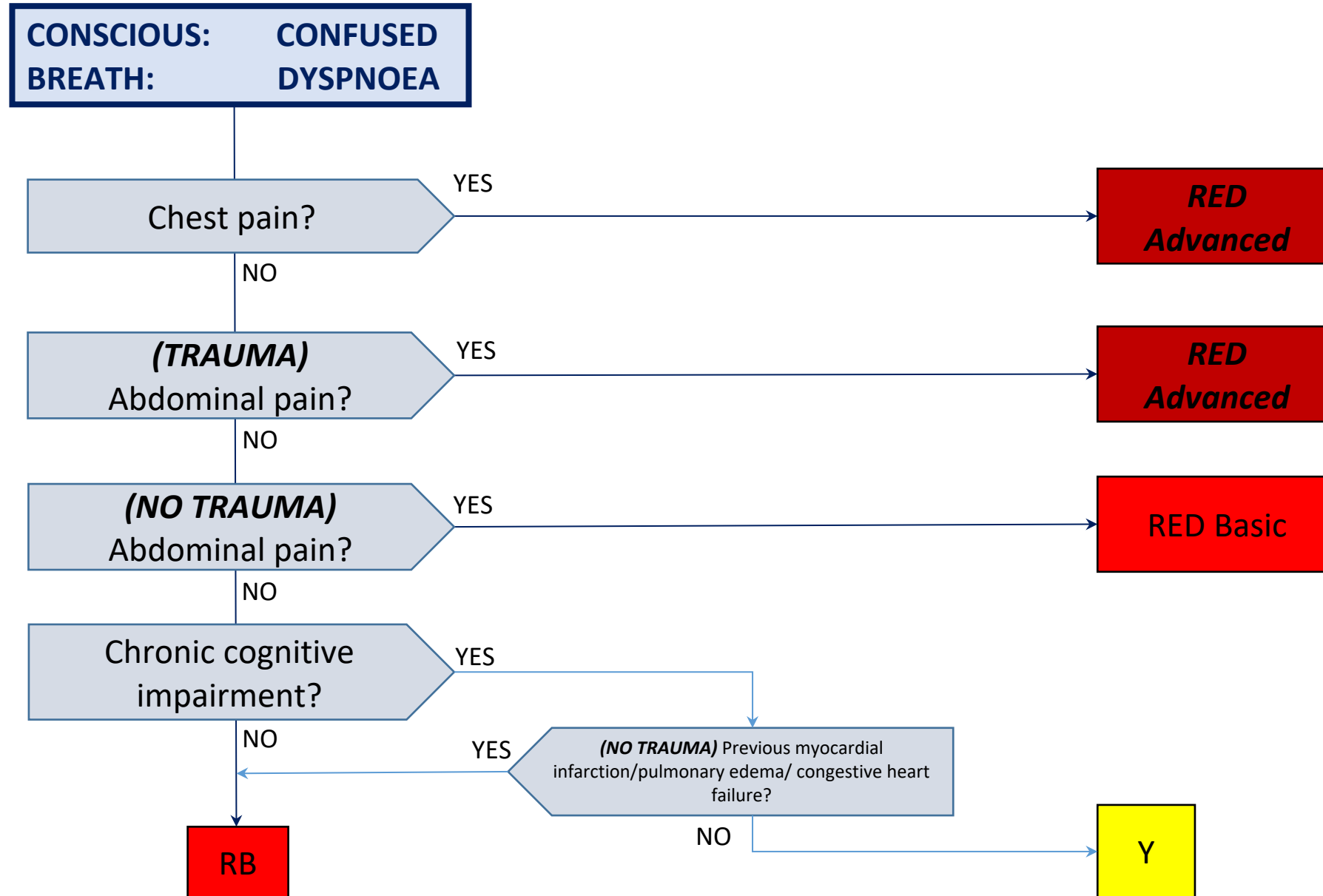

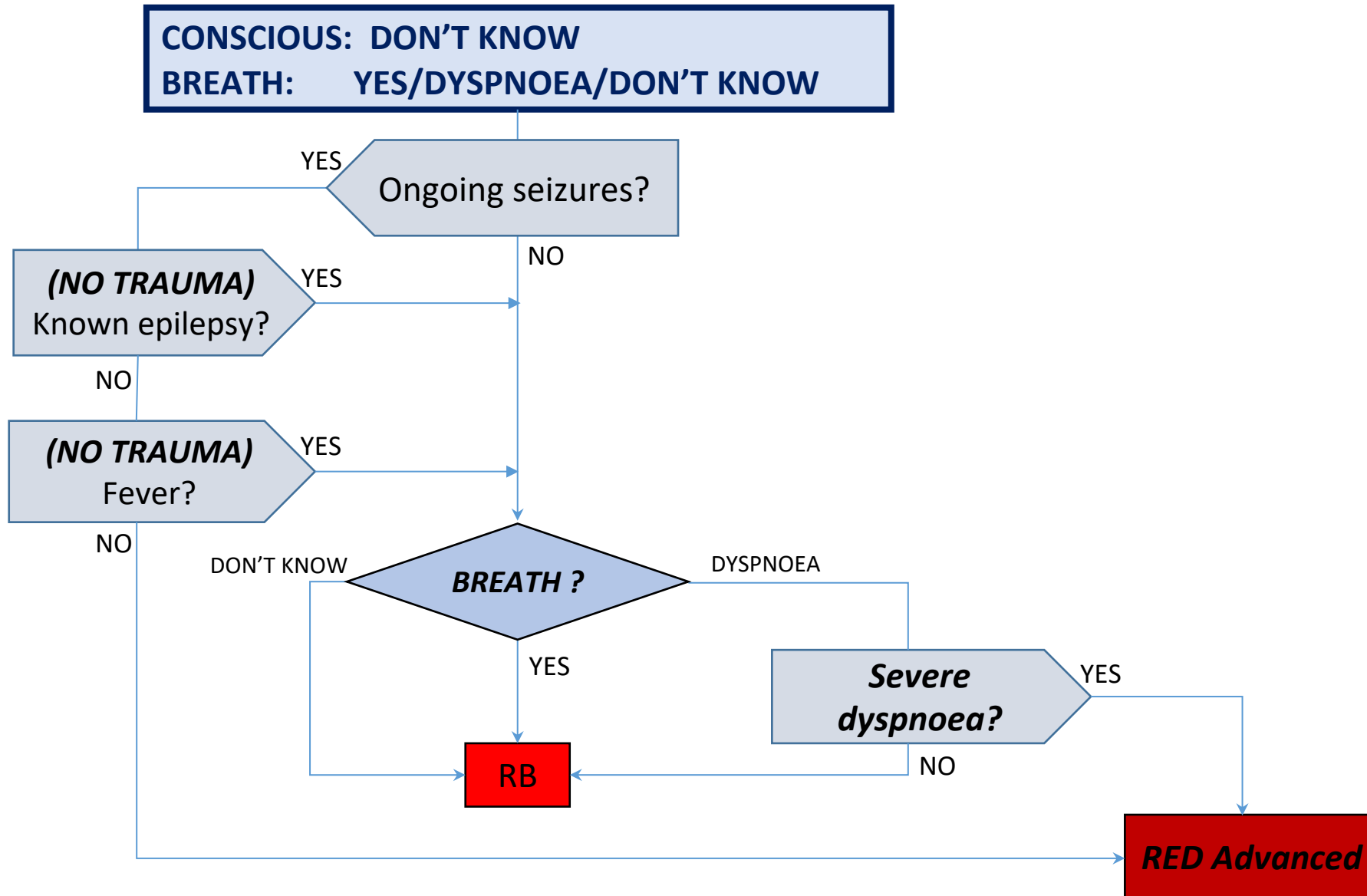
