### About Mi Familia Vota & OCA

Mi Familia Vota (MFV) is a national 501(c)(4) civic engagement organization that focuses on Latino, immigrant, and allied community interests. Through its marketing and programing, it conducts voter mobilization campaigns through workshops, voter registration drives, and voter mobilization efforts and currently operates in the states of Arizona, California, Colorado, Florida, Nevada, and Texas (Lamb 2020). On MFV's official website, the organization lists their mission, in English and in Spanish, as follows:

*Mi Familia Vota's mission is to build Latino political power by expanding the electorate, strengthening local infrastructures, and through year-round voter engagement.*

*La misión de Mi Familia Vota es construir el poder político latino mediante la ampliación del electorado, el fortalecimiento de las infraestructuras locales y la participación de los votantes durante todo el año.*

OCA-Asian Pacific American Advocates is a civic engagement organization that primarily seeks to increase participation by the Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI) population in the United States. Similar to MFV, it also conducts programing aimed at increasing local participation and voter engagement. OCA's local Houston chapter is called OCA-Greater Houston, or OCA-GH. On OCA-GH's official website, the organization lists its mission as follows:

*OCA-Greater Houston is a volunteer driven organization of community advocates that strives to meet the current and evolving needs of a diverse population through comprehensive continuum of programs targeting different life stages of AAPIs with a focus on developing advocacy, leadership, and civic engagement participation of AAPIs.*
