What do the results show? First of all, that the results of Table 1 are robust to replacing EFW2 with ROL. This holds both when done without EFW1, EFW3, EFW4 an EFW5 (column 1) and when done with them (column 9). Then, it turns out that the effect stems from the second main part of ROL, quality of enforcement, and from its component checks and balances. This component reflects the degree to which there are checks on the executive, judicial independence, judicial accountability and prosecutorial independence. Where these features of a political-legal order are strong, antisemitism is likely to be less prevalent.

Second, we have carried out a similar exercise whereby we have replaced EFW4 with elements from the KOF Globalization Index (Gygli *et al.*, 2019). The results are presented in Tables A15a and A15b. They are discussed in the paper on pp. 16–17. In Table A15a, the measures are *de facto* (showing actual flows and connections) and in Table A15b *de jure* (showing the degree to which institutions allow for actual flows and connections).

The findings reveal that none of the *de facto* measures are statistically significant but that several of the *de jure* measures are. This suggests that it is the rules in place that shape people's attitudes towards Jews rather than actual flows or activities. (This result is the reason for including a more detailed analysis, in columns 10-12, for the *de jure* measures only.)

More specifically, both parts of *de jure* economic globalization – trade globalization and financial globalization – are positively related to antisemitism when entered individually; but when entered together, it is financial globalization that drives the result (quite in line with our theory). Interestingly, we also find that two components of *de jure* social globalization – interpersonal globalization and cultural globalization – are also related to antisemitism, but with opposing signs. Rules allowing for more interpersonal contact are related to more antisemitism, while rules allowing for more cultural interaction are related to less antisemitism. This holds both when they are entered individually and together. However, social globalization is not captured by EFW4. Political globalization is not significant when entered on its own, but when entered together with the other five parts of economic and social globalization, it is positive and significant. In that regression, the positive association between financial globalization and antisemitism is confirmed even when other aspects of globalization are controlled for. Lastly, when replacing EFW4 with the KOF Economic Globalization Index, the results of Table 1 hold: Economic globalization is positively related to antisemitism, while EFW2 stands in a negative association to antisemitism.





Note: The bars show the share of respondents that is antisemitic (measured by the ADL index) across European countries in 2014.





Figure A3. The EFW index and the ADL index.

Figure A4. The marginal effect of economic freedom over GDP per capita, education and religious fractionalization






Figure A5. The marginal effect of economic freedom over urban population, dependency ratio and Muslim share



## *Extended analysis testing whether anti-market sentiments interact with EFW4 to generate antisemitism – discussed on p. 17 of the manuscript*

In order to test whether a feature of our theoretical framework (illustrated in arrow 5c in Figure 1), viz., that anti-market sentiments based on folk-economic beliefs interact with EFW4 to generate antisemitism, obtains support in the data, we have undertaken the following analysis:

1. We have selected four indicators of 'anti-market sentiments' from the World Values Survey: the share in each country that pick the most 'anti-market' reply, on a ten-point scale. This means the share agreeing with the following four statements:

- Government ownership of business should be increased.
- The government should take more responsibility to ensure that everyone is provided for.
- Competition is harmful. It brings out the worst in people.
- People can only get rich at the expense of others.

We have used the latest available data for each country (with wave 6 being the latest one available, with data up until 2014; the question numbers there are V97–V99 and V101). 2. We then used the baseline regression model for EFW4 ('trade openness') as specified in column 5 of Table 1 and added these four indicators, one at a time, along with an interaction with EFW4. The interaction corresponds to our theoretical argument that beliefs about and attitudes towards the market economy influences the degree to which EFW4 affects antisemitism. In a setting where people believe that markets do not work for 'the common good', an institutional regime giving markets free reign will be regarded with more suspicion, not least allowing for ideas that only certain groups benefit from them (such as Jews).

The results are presented in the form of four marginal plots, Figures A 7–A10 below, showing, in each case, how the size of the point estimate of EFW4 varies with the degree of anti-market sentiments. The advantage of using these plots to illustrate the interaction effects is that the effect for the whole distribution of reply shares can be seen (see Brambor *et al.*, 2006, for a motivation). The dashed lines show the 95% confidence interval.





Figure A7. Marginal plot based on an interaction between EFW4 and the share holding most strongly that government ownership of business should be increased

Figure A8. Marginal plot based on an interaction between EFW4 and the share holding most strongly that the government should take more responsibility to ensure that everyone is provided for







Figure A9. Marginal plot based on an interaction between EFW4 and the share holding most strongly that competition is harmful as it brings out the worst in people

What do the four plots show?

- That the antisemitism-inducing effect of EFW4 increases in the share stating most strongly that government ownership of business should be increased, and this interaction effect is statistically significant at the 5% level from a reply share of about 18% upwards.
- That the antisemitism-inducing effect of EFW4 increases in the share stating most strongly that the government should take more responsibility to ensure that everyone is provided for, and this interaction effect is statistically significant at the 5% level from a reply share of about 22% upwards.
- That the antisemitism-inducing effect of EFW4 increases in the share stating most strongly that competition is harmful as it brings out the worst in people, and this interaction effect is statistically significant for reply shares between 6% and 14%.
- That the antisemitism-inducing effect of EFW4 increases in the share stating most strongly that people can only get rich at the expense of others; however, this effect is not statistically significant at the 5% level.

Hence, our basic theoretical idea seems to obtain support through this interaction analysis: In each case, the positive point estimate of EFW4 is increasing in the degree of 'anti-market' sentiments, and significantly for substantial parts of the distributions of the reply shares in three cases.








Figure A13. Marginal plot based on an interaction between the share of Protestants and EFW2
