Matching Techniques Attempted to Reduce Bias

Five different matching routines were conducted in an effort to reduce bias between the control and the treatment groups, the results of each Model's reduction in bias can be found in Table 1.

- 1. Model 1: Normal kernel matching, only using observations on common support, using replacement, trimming bottom 5% of cases, with a caliper of 0.06
- 2. Model 2: Using default routine of psmatch2- nearest neighborhood matching with no restrictions on common support, no trimming of cases and no caliper, with replacement
- 3. Model 3: Normal kernel matching, only using observations on common support, using replacement, trimming bottom 2% of cases, with a caliper of 0.10
- 4. Model 4: Biweight kernel matching, no restrictions on common support, using replacement, trimming bottom 2% of cases, with a caliper of 0.10
- 5. Model 5: Using default routine of psmatch2- nearest neighborhood matching with no restrictions on common support, no trimming of cases and no caliper, without replacement

Alternate Tolerance Models

In addition to creating a combined index of tolerance, other analysis was conducted to examine tolerance questions by target group. Table 3 groups the 'targets' (atheists, racists, communists, militarists, and homosexuals) of intolerance together into individual measures in an effort to see which specific groups generate the observed effect.
