## ONLINE APPENDIX A: $\rho$ PER MEASUREMENT PAIR

In calculating  $\rho$  for countries, we have to drop (a) countries where one or both measures do not vary over time and (b) countries with fewer than two observations per measure. This is because a correlation coefficient cannot be estimated for those countries. Table 6 shows for each right the number of countries for which  $\rho$  could be calculated along with the number for which it could not. The first column contains the name of the right measured by the CIRI–V–Dem pair, the second column contains the number of countries for which  $\rho$  could be calculated, and the third column contains the number of countries for which  $\rho$  could not be calculated.
