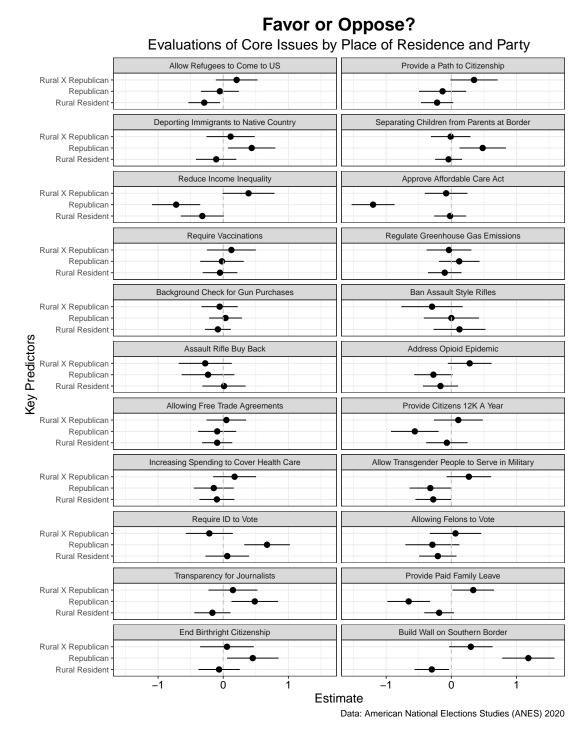


Figure 1: Regression Results for Key Issues by Party Identification and Place of Residence

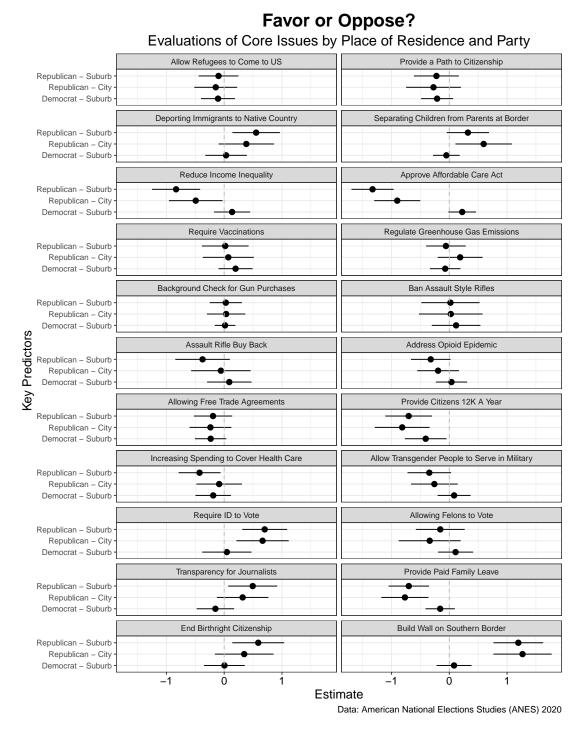


Figure 2: Regression Results to Compare City and Suburb residents by Party
