


Fig. DS1 Comparisons between participant experiences with staff and other members at the Anxiety Disorders Residential Unit




Fig. DS2 Comparisons between participant experiences with staff and other members at the therapeutic community




Fig. DS3 Comparisons between participant experiences with staff and other members at the in-patient unit
