Quality Content (70%)

Step 1: Selecting Top Platforms/Authors/Websites

Criteria

- Routinely cited in the manosphere (*e.g.*, Rollo Tomassi)
- Studied by other manosphere scholars/identified as influential by manosphere scholars (*e.g.*, Return of Kings)



Step 2: Selecting Top Material

Criteria

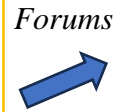
- As measured by number of views (YouTube), upvotes (Reddit), or comments (blogs).
- Material showcased by the website, such as in the homepage (*e.g.*, incels.wiki), or in a “must-read” section (*e.g.*, incels.is).
- Foundational manifestoes and texts that have been conserved by communities (*e.g.*, The Red Pill sidebar).

Random Sample (15%)

Step 1: Selecting Platforms/Authors/Websites

Criteria

- All active (or exhaustively archived) websites from Quality Content in which content is user-generated (*i.e.*, forums and subreddits.)



Step 2: Filtering

- “Utility” sections of forums, such as “Rules” or “Introductions”, are removed from the pool.



Step 3: Random Draw

- Details in Supplementary Material S2.



Step 2: Filtering

- To avoid spams/junk submissions, posts with karma of zero are removed from the pool.



Step 3: Random Draw

Other Related Material (15%)

Selecting Relevant Material

- Manosphere primary sources dealing with evolutionary sciences, or life sciences in general.
 - Three years of browsing manosphere websites and platforms.
 - Targeted keyword searches with terms such as “Darwinian” or “evolutionary”
